



Str8 Juice Youth Program

Program Overview:

The Str8 Juice Youth Program provides high school students with hands-on experience in food service, entrepreneurship, and wellness. Participants assist with daily operations at Str8 Juice while learning about healthy food preparation, customer service, and business management.

Participant Eligibility:

- Ages 14-18
- Must have reliable transportation
- Must commit to at least 2 shifts per week
- Interested in health, food, entrepreneurship, or community service.

Responsibilities:

- Greet customers in a friendly and professional manner
- Take customer orders accurately at the counter
- Preparing menu items, including but not limited to, smoothies and cold-pressed juices
- Restocking cups, straws, napkins, and ingredients
- Inventory
- Helping create social media content
- Learning about nutrition and plant-based ingredients

This is a general list, and additional tasks may be required of participants as asked by the Program Coordinator.

Work Schedule:

Participants are required to work at least 2 shifts per week. Upon acceptance into the program, participants will receive a list of available shifts. It is the responsibility of the youth to

communicate with the Program Coordinator which shifts they want at least 2 weeks before the shift date.

Food Truck Shifts:

Participants can work their shifts on the Str8 Juice Food Truck at various locations. These events may be shorter or longer than the typical 4-hour shift. Before signing up for these events, participants must ensure reliable transportation to the event. We will not give out rides to any event. The event locations and shift times will be listed.

Stipend:

Participants will receive a total of \$900 paid out biweekly on Fridays. The pay schedule is below.

Training:

Participants must complete at least 3 trainings before the program start date. These training sessions are unpaid but will count toward community service hours. Each training will be a 4-hour shift.

Program Expectations:

- Arrive on time for every shift
- Follow food safety procedures learned during training
- Treat customers and coworkers respectfully
- Complete assigned tasks
- Communicate schedule conflicts in advance

Failure to meet expectations may result in removal from the program. If a participant is asked to leave the program, they will not receive the remainder of their stipend.

Community Service Hours:

All trainings will count toward community service hours. Additionally, any shift worked after the 2 required shifts will count toward community service hours. Love Always Foundation hosts

Rejuvenation Sundays in Bradner, OH, to which all participants will be invited to attend for additional community service hours.

All participants will receive a certificate upon completion of the program. Participants will be acknowledged on our social media accounts and website. Additionally, participants will be eligible for Letters of Recommendation for future education, employment, etc.
